

Dear Reception year parent or carer,
The East Sussex School Health Service offers three programmes for reception-aged children including:

- **a health needs assessment (HNA) survey – completed online by a child's parent or carer**
- **vision screening**
- **the National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP)**

Your child's online Health Needs Assessment (HNA) takes around 10-15 minutes to complete and can be accessed using this link <https://app.schoolscreeener.com/Portal/#/3232/p/esh104/146786>.

You'll receive an email with your survey responses and this can also be viewed on your **School Screener parent portal**. A nurse will review the questionnaire and may contact you to offer health advice, information and support if needed

The School Health Team will be visiting your child's school in roughly two weeks' time to complete the vision screening and NCMP programmes. Further information on these programmes is attached to this email. You can opt out of the programme if you would rather your child doesn't take part by accessing your **parent portal** account. We'll assume that you are happy for us to see your child in school if we don't hear from you. You'll be able to view you child's results for their vision screening and NCMP measurements as well as your responses to their health needs assessment survey here. You'll have secure, 24-hour access to all personalised data for your children with one username and password.
