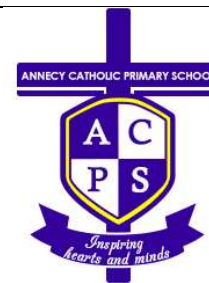
We wish you all a restful, fun and healthy summer. Remember grown ups, you are never too old to play!
